About the Scholarship

The scholarship will fund 1 successful applicant to participate in the 6 or 12 month Noble Leaders Group Coaching Program. Enrolment is continuous with no specific starting date. We are kicking off our next group on 5 March. The Program Page here details all inclusions.

*The program is conducted in English.

Eligibility and Selection

If you identify as one or more of the following you are eligible to apply:

- Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander person
- Women over 55
- Person with a disability
- Minority Ethnic (including second generation)
- Person who identifies as LGBTQIA
- Work for a social enterprise, not for profit or community services sector organisation
- Emerging Leader (under 25 engaged in a purpose-driven organisation or initiative, with leadership responsibilities)

In addition, eligible applicants must:

- be able to participate in the monthly and quarterly sessions
- contribute a service to the program, based on our mutual agreement based on strengths and interests
- submit a completed application form. There is no deadline.

Application Process

- Recipients will be selected on the basis of their application. There is no interview (unless a written application is not possible for the applicant.)
- All applicants will be reviewed by Barasa Consulting Group. The final decision regarding the selection of the successful applicants will be at the discretion of Barasa Consulting Group. The reasons for our decision will not be reported publicly.

Terms and Conditions

- The scholarship is non-transferrable
- Applicants acknowledge there is no alternative offer in the event that the whole or any part of the Noble Leaders Group Coaching Program does not run for any reason.
- If you agree, we would ask you to participate in acknowledging our scholarship winners (This is not a requirement for successful applicants. We will maintain confidentiality if this is your preference).
